One day, his soldiers gathered up an entire church choir in the town of Chalcedon - a group of forty-nine people - and executed all of them.

### COVID Update

Decree from Bishop McKnight effective on **September 12, 2020.** (See the Diocesan website for the link to the official decree.) Those in the Diocese of Jefferson City are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation from **September 12 - November 27, 2020** provided one of the following are completed:

- A. Participate in Sunday or holy day of obligation Mass live streamed from your parish, the Cathedral, or the Vatican.
- B. Prayerfully read and meditate on the readings of the Mass for the Sunday or holy day of obligation and recite either the rosary or Divine Mercy chaplet.
